







Scope and Sequence: Fast ForWord Reading Level 1

The Fast ForWord Reading Level 1 exercises help students strengthen fundamental cognitive skills that are critical to learning across the curriculum:

- Auditory processing
- Sequencing
- Memory
- Attention

These cognitive skills are developed in the context of learning activities that simultaneously help students improve their English language arts and reading skills.

Exercise	Primary Task	Supports these classroom skills
Bear Bags 	Sort pictures or written words by first, last, or middle sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phonemic awareness • Letter-sound correspondence
Magic Rabbit 	Choose the correct letter to change one word into another	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spelling • Letter-sound correspondence • Phonemic awareness
Flying Fish 	Find the written word that matches a spoken word	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decoding skills • Sight-word recognition • Left-to-right visual tracking
Quail Mail 	Sort pictures and words into increasingly challenging categories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vocabulary • Categorizing
Bedtime Beasties 	Complete sentences by filling in the missing word	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (using context) • Vocabulary
Buzz Fly 	Listen, read along, and answer questions about increasingly challenging passages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (of fiction and non-fiction text) • Answering “wh-“ questions • Vocabulary
