






Scope and Sequence: Fast ForWord Reading Level 5

The Fast ForWord Reading Level 5 exercises help students strengthen fundamental cognitive skills that are critical to learning across the curriculum:

- Auditory processing
- Sequencing
- Memory
- Attention

These cognitive skills are developed in the context of learning activities that simultaneously help students improve their English language arts and reading skills.

Exercise	Primary Task	Supports these classroom skills
<p>Wood Works</p> 	Categorize words by sound and by spelling pattern	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spelling (varied spelling patterns for each phoneme) • Decoding • Phonemic awareness
<p>Toad Loader</p> 	Build a sentence that describes the picture by selecting the correct words and phrases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (sentence) • Vocabulary • Grammar
<p>Gator Jam</p> 	Select the word to complete an analogy and sort each analogy by type	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (sentence) • Vocabulary • Logical reasoning
<p>Lana's Lanes</p> 	Read a passage, work with a graphic organizer or summary, and then answer questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (fiction and non-fiction; strategies) • Summarizing • Graphic organizers (tables, diagrams, concept webs, flowcharts, and timelines) • Logical reasoning
<p>Quack Splash</p> 	Build a passage by selecting missing words, phrases, and sentences, sequencing sentences into paragraphs, and sequencing paragraphs into pages, and then answer questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (fiction and non-fiction) • Writing/editing skills (selecting relevant information, creating a logical flow of ideas, using transitional expressions) • Figurative language (metaphor, simile, idiom) • Answering questions
